



Shelsley Walsh Hill Climb Entry – Terms & Conditions

- Participants take part in the hill climb entirely at their own risk. Neither Food&Fuel nor Shelsley Walsh will accept liability for any injuries or damage to participants, passengers, or vehicles resulting from participation.
- Each participating vehicle is allowed a maximum of one passenger.
- Entries to the hill climb are strictly non-refundable.
- All participating vehicles must be maintained in a road-legal condition, possessing current road tax, insurance, and a valid MOT certificate where applicable, unless prior agreement has been explicitly confirmed by Food&Fuel.
- No individuals under the age of 12 years old are permitted to participate or be passengers in the hill climb.
- Drivers and passengers must wear a properly fitting crash helmet at all times during the hill climb.
- Participants must arrive on-site by 08:00. Attendance at the mandatory drivers' briefing is required; failure to attend will result in exclusion from the hill climb.
- Participants are responsible for ensuring that they hold adequate insurance coverage. Standard road insurance policies may not cover participation in this event.
- Drivers and passengers must wear comfortable clothing that fully covers arms (to the wrists) and legs (to the ankles). Wearing racing overalls or equivalent protective clothing is highly recommended.
- Participants must submit all additional information and completed forms by the specified deadlines. Failure to do so may result in the withdrawal of their entry.
