HILL CLIMB TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Participants take part in the hill climb entirely at their own risk. Neither Food&Fuel nor Shelsley Walsh will accept liability for any injuries or damage to participants, passengers, or vehicles resulting from participation.
- Participants must attend with their approved vehicle for their hill climb place. Vehicle changes are not permitted without prior approval, and unapproved substitute vehicles may be refused entry or excluded from taking part.
- Drivers and passengers must wear a properly fitting crash helmet at all times during the hill climb. FULL face helmets are mandatory for open top cars and there are a limited number of helmets available to hire if required.
- No individuals under the age of 12 years old are permitted to participate or be passengers in the hill climb.
- Participants are responsible for ensuring that they hold adequate insurance coverage. Standard road insurance policies may not cover participation in this event.
- Drivers and passengers must wear clothing that fully covers arms (to the wrists) and legs (to the ankles). Wearing racing overalls or equivalent protective clothing is highly recommended.
- Participants must arrive on-site during the arrival window specified pre-event. Attendance at the mandatory drivers' briefing is required. Failure to attend may result in exclusion from the hill climb.
- Entries to the hill climb are strictly non-refundable.
- Participants must submit all additional information and completed forms by the specified deadlines. Failure to do so may result in the withdrawal of their entry.
- Participants must follow all instructions given by event officials and marshals at all times. Dangerous or anti-social driving will result in immediate exclusion without refund.
- Participants are responsible for ensuring their vehicle is in a safe and suitable condition. Food&Fuel reserves the right to refuse participation to any vehicle deemed unsafe or unsuitable.
